Project Story

Cala Homes, in the west of Scotland wanted to use a design which had a natural feel and style. They needed the play area to provide a large number of play activities for children of all ages.

The project had to adhere to the planning conditions which have been in place for many years, from the process of application through to competition.

our naturally focused design was selected for the project, the design mainly consisted of our origin range as this is made of Robinia hardwood, which gave the play area a rural aesthetic. our designer used a meandering pathway through the site with each of the play activities set out on either side. in addition to the main climbing frames and swings, there is an extended fun trail and lots of large boulders to enhance the natural feel of the play area.



The play area really looks great, and fits in perfectly within the backdrop to the surrounding homes. The kids are going to love it!
