To create a new play space that would provide the children and residents of Rhodesia, an ex-mining community, a new and exciting space to play.

From the initial concept drawings to the final realisation of this unique project, the key focus was to deliver a scheme that was a true reflection of the mining heritage of the area. This was achieved by incorporating bespoke play items such as the Toddler tunnelling machine, intricate themed ground graphics and a cog shaped seating area. Other items included a variety of swings, a large Biibox climbing unit, Spinning Bowls, Trampolines and a Goal End and cycle machines to engage Teenagers.

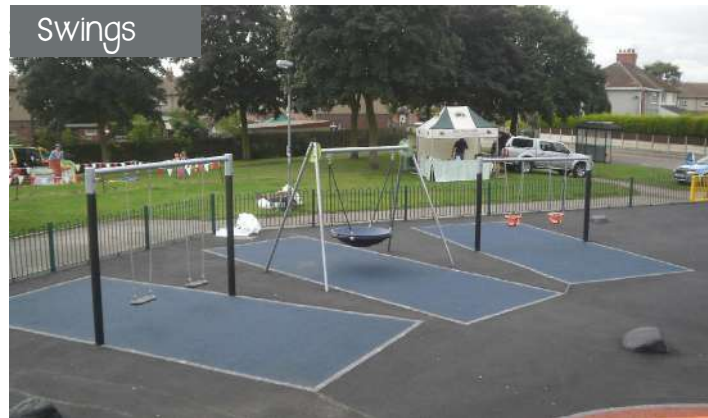
