Project Story

After

In 2005, Sturton Le Steeple Parish Council undertook a major project to create new play facilities for the local community. As preferred suppliers, Proludic aided Sturton Le Steeple Parish Council with its funding bid; providing quotes and designs over a two year period. The arishes plan was to update and modernise the current play facilities available in the village and to provide play provision suitable for all ages.

The new play area completed in December 2007 includes imaginative and social play opportunities. For younger children, a castle theme has been created by installing a brightly coloured castle multi-play unit. This allows them to slide, climb and create their own games. Inspired by the natural range, the Kanope multi-play unit is an exciting play item for the older child which stands at 3.8m high and is designed based on a tree-top hut. The Dynamic equipment has been installed for the twelve plus age range and is designed to thrill and challenge, the Rodeo Board and Twinfly simulate extreme sports. The area has received a fantastic response from the local residents and children.

The site, at the centre of the village creates an area that the entire community can use and enjoy together. Timber based products were chosen to blend in with the local environment.
