Project Story

Proludic Ltd were approached by Tollerton Parish Council to assist with the complete replacement of an existing old and tired timber framed MUGA. The aim was to provide the residents with a completely new facility that would cater for users of all abilities and provide a space to both practice skills in small groups with friends and to have the adaptability to be hired for competitive games, generating income for the Parish Council.

The facility Proludic provided was a bespoke $38m \times 18m \times 3m$ high MUGA system constructed from a combined Single Twin Wire and Super Rebound Mes providing the strength and durability to withstand heavy ball use. Rubber inserts between the posts and panels offer reduced vibration, therefore, reduced noise pollution. The playing surface is a brand new tarmacadam area with line markings for football, basketball and tennis. 2 lockable entrance gates allows the council to secure the site if required.
