The Suspended World

A suspended world means exploring new ways of playing and managing space and heights. It means creating a world in which users never touch the ground, providing a real test of balance and self-control. The trails demand strength, flexibility and balance as well as concentration to successfully pass from one element to another. Children explore an airborne trail in a fun, acrobatic, original ways, through structures connected to the pyramid, the central element in the Suspended World: the arch, the swaying unstable footbridge and the cableway, which is 4m long. The nest is placed during these physical elements and provides a place to take a short rest or catch your breath.
