Project Story

The Grand Western Canal Country Park and Local Nature Reserve is a long linear park based around the in-water section of the Grand Western Canal in Devon.

The Park contains a wealth of wildlife and historic structures and a Canal Visitor Centre. The Canal is probably best known for the horse-drawn barge, called Tivertonian. Passengers have been enjoying peaceful and leisurely cruises on board this barge for over 40 years. It is estimated that the canal attracts around 295,000 visits per year. Despite this large number of visitors, there has been relatively little to engage or excite children visiting the Canal Basin, with the notable exception of the horses.

After consultation with stakeholders, visitors and local residents there was one consistent theme that came from the discussions. The play area needed to relate to the canal and accomodate children aged 3-8 years old.

Proludic were chosen to create the play area and desiged an exact replica play barge. This play area provides an extension of the local heritage and offers role play opportunity for children visiting the Canal.


