Project Story

Central Bedfordshire Council undertook an assessment of play sites within the district and identified the play spaces that were in greatest need of improvement. A consultation was also carried out at this stage for ideas and it was decided 11 bespoke play areas would need to be created by one company. Proludic was approached through the ESPO Framework to provide a proposal for the Playbuilder project phase 1. This involved development of 11 play areas in line with DCSF Playbuilder criteria. Proludic submitted a tender and were awarded the contract based on their ability to understand the needs of the project.

Proludic prepared a design rationale for each site explaining in detail the design factors of each submission; taking into consideration the aesthetics of the site, the themes and requests that the children provided during the consultation and the needs of residents, parents and carers. 11 state-of-the-art play sites were completed to Playbuilder standards and deadlines. Each site has been designed to fulfil the specific requirements of that area and is unique.
