Padstow Parish Council wanted to refurbish old and tired facilities within the area. Part of the existing facilities had been closed for 6 months and parents living nearby were keen to see it reopen due to a lack of adequate facilities.

Proludic helped Padstow with the consultation and based on the communities feedback designed a play area that was modern, versatile and exciting. To highlight the local and famous sea history of Padstow, Proludic created a nautical theme throughout the space. A multi-play tanker ship was included and complimented by bright wetpour safety surfacing graphics which included images of crabs, anchors and fish. These items are great for encouraging imaginative play.

Inclusive play items have also been included in the scheme so children of all abilities can join in on the fun. Proludic installed this play area in 2009 and despite being in the ground for a long period of time, the play equipment still looks current, vibrant and appealing.
