Project Story

Stevenage Borough Council wanted to refurbish the whole area at Peartree Park. They had £50,000 to spend so a decision was made to hold a consultation event with the local public to see what they would like in their park. The area is located next to the Primary School Lewis Hamilton, Formula 1 champion, attended. The public wanted the design to be based on this theme. The challenge for Proludic was to create a bespoke and themed area achievable within the councils budget.

Proludic designed the area based on a race track with a start and finish marker. The area itself was installed on wetpour surfacing so Proludic were able to incorporate themed graphics within the wetpour. A bespoke Formula 1 race car unit was created for Peartree Park to be the focal point of the play area. Proludic also installed swings, 2 race car themed springer's, speed gyro and a space net. Gordon Drake at Stevenage Borough Council said "The boys and girls of Stevenage are thrilled with their latest playground. The design details really does give this play area the WOW factor." The local public are thrilled with the new area and all of this has been achieved within the councils budget.
