Coopers Edge is a large development in Gloucestershire, built by a consortium of developers. Proludic worked closely with the project management company, WYG to deliver a high-quality LEAP for one of the Public Open Spaces areas within the development. We engaged with the Local Authority, Stroud District Council on behalf of our client to ensure that the plans were accepted under the planning agreement and would be easily adopted.

The development is on the old site of the renowned Brockworth airfield, which played a major part in the development and manufacture of aircraft between 1915 and the mid-1960s. This history was used to inspire elements of the play area with the runway and aircraft included in graphics within the wetpour. The finished site looks fantastic and is of a high specification, offering a brilliant asset to the growing community within Coopers Edge.

Play for Housing - LEAP

An area of open space that included equipment for children who are beginning to experience play independently. LEAP's should be designed to ensure the area can be used for physical activities alongside play equipment.

Key Features:

. Its primary function is to engage local children and encourage growth, within a 5-minute walking distance from the child's house - 20 meters minimum separation between activity zone and the boundary of dwellings.
