Project Story

Somerset West and Taunton district council engaged with a landscape architect to revamp Minehead's seafront. As the site is in a prominent tourist location they were looking to create a new play space with a theme that reflected the coastal location. The Proludic ship wreck multiplay unit became an iconic centre piece for this location. Additional aquatic themed items were added such as the calypso play structure and Frankie the Fish and Danny the Dolphin Springers which all come together to add to the theme and give additional play values.

Themed equipment provides children, aged from 2 to 8 years, with a stage in the playground on which to act out stories and live numerous adventures.
