The Principal, Louise Greatrex was keen to source products that were suitable for her students who are aged 11+ on the autistic spectrum and have a related communication disorder. They had been previously offered trim trail type equipment most often seen in Primary Schools for much younger children, offering very few challenges for learning and developing.

The newly revitalised outdoor space can be used freely and for fun by students as well as forming a facility that can be used as part of the specially tailored PE curriculum.
