Threatened by closure Friends of Acredale Park required some guidance and support in raising the required finance for ensuring this key park for the area was kept open. They wanted a park for their community involving all age groups from the elderly to nursery and school children.

Proludic guided Friends of Acredale Park through the funding process ensuring that the right amount was secured to make their dreams a reality. Play equipment for children includes a zip wire, and there is a central seating and tabled area where families can congregate.

Officially opened in July 2011 Acredale Park renamed Cara's park after a young girl who died suddenly has become a real asset to the community who worked tirelessly to ensure its opening. Maintained and cared for by local residents, it's set to remain a real hub of energy.
