Gallagher Estates and the Bedford Design Group wanted a LEAP (Local Equipped Area for Play) designing for a new town development in Bedford called Wixams. They wanted the site to be aimed at children aged 4-12 years but also be considerate to other age groups and abilities. The site needed to allow free and creative play with some seating options for parents and quardians.

Proludic worked with Gallaghers and Bedford Design Group to create a flagship park for the area. The use of boulders and sand ensure a successful combination of textures, colour and landscaping which is sympathetic to its setting. Play Within Housing

LEAP - An area of open space that included equipment for children who are beginning to experience play independently. LEAP's should be designed to ensure the area can be used for physical activities alongside play equipment.

. Its primary function is to engage local children and encourage growth, within a 5-minute walking distance from the child's house - 20 meters minimum separation between activity zone and the boundary of dwellings.
