Project Story

Marwell wanted to create an Australian theme in their new encounter village play park to reflect the animals in that part of the zoo. As a major visitor attraction, they required a play area where the choice of equipment complemented the zoo by being both 'hands on' and natural in appearance. Educational play was also important to them, so children could learn about the zoo while playing - particularly with many schools visiting the attraction.

Proludic installed their Kanope multi-play unit to the site which is themed around tree houses and blends seamlessly into the natural environment. A sand play unit was also put in incorporating a 'desert' theme to replicate the savannah environment from Australia.

We also worked with Playgrounds UK to install educational themed wet pour which uses aboriginal inspired symbols - teaching children about this Australian tradition.





We have a season ticket for 2 years and visit regularly with our family. One of the positives to this visitor attraction is the outdoor play park which is absolutely fantastic, the children love it!













Themed Play

Themed equipment encourages children to use their imagination. They can be adventurers on boats, trains, rockets, fire engines, lions or dinosaurs. The Adventure themed equipment transports children into the leafy undergrowth of a jungle.

They can give free rein to their imagination, stimulated by the numerous details and original elements on each item of equipment.
